Keep It Clean By: Dr. Charles Stanley

You may feel alone in the things you've done wrong today, but realize: everyone sins. We all do things we shouldn't. Certainly, the longer we follow Jesus, the more we should mature spiritually and walk in increasing freedom from the sin nature. In fact, the Holy Spirit indwells to keep us in the center of God's will and to convict us quickly when we err. So when we sin, our first response should be, "Lord, forgive me and help me never to do that again!"
